The Legacy Cup Committee of the American Hunter-Jumper Foundation would like to welcome you to the arrival of the 2008 Legacy Cup. This year we continue our partnership with the Kentucky Spring Horse Shows with another two-week event, providing exhibitors scheduling flexibility and the opportunity to take advantage of pairing their Legacy Cup experience with one of the nation's top AA rated hunter events.

We continue to refine the format for Legacy Cup and 2008 will be no exception. However, throughout this refinement we remain focused on our original goal: to present an innovative, high paying, exhibitor-friendly event.

The Legacy Cup offers five divisions. There are two professional divisions; one at 3' and one at 3'6". Within the pro division we also award new or developing riders Restricted Professional Awards. There are two non-pro divisions; one at 3' and 3'6", and the Legacy Cup Pony Hunter Division.

The 2008 Legacy Cup entry fee is \$400—50% going directly to the division purse and 50% to The American Hunter-Jumper Foundation for the expenses associated with the event. This allows for substantial prize money with less expense to the exhibitor. Each division offers one go-round to rank the top twenty-five horses for a clean slate final. All rounds are judged numerically by multiple sets of two judges positioned around the ring.

Recent Legacy Cup events have proved to be very successful. On the heels of that success, we are able to give back to the exhibitors by adding \$13,000 to the event divisions. This added money, combined with 50% of the division entry fee, will create an even more high paying event, growing with each horse entered. We will maintain the guaranteed purse of \$1,500 for each go-round. In the non pro divisions, overall ribbons and separate ribbons are awarded for both juniors and amateurs in all classes, and the Signature Trophy recognizes the high money winning Junior Hunter. There are leading non-pro rider awards in each division and a Legacy Cup Non Pro Team Award. For the professional division, we feature the Pre Green Incentive, the Belcort Farm Perpetual Trophy and the Walter J. Lee Perpetual Trophy.

Once again, we have worked to design this event to be as exhibitor, spectator, and horse friendly as possible. We invite you to join us at this great facility in beautiful Lexington, Kentucky. To compete in the Legacy Cup, riders, owners and trainers must be current members of the American Hunter-Jumper Foundation, Inc.

ADD BACK PURSE: 50% OF ALL ENTRY FEES COLLECTED FROM EACH DIVISION WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THAT DIVISION.

PRIZE MONEY will be credited to horse's account. Money will be paid to the owner of record unless otherwise instructed on the entry blank. **All prize money recipients MUST provide a social security or TIN number before prize money will be paid.** Prize money remaining at the conclusion of the show will be mailed.

RIBBONS will be awarded in the ring. All Go Rounds will be awarded 1st–10th place ribbons. Legacy Cup Finals will be awarded 1st–12th place ribbons.

FORMAL ATTIRE is required for all Legacy Cup Finals Classes.

ENTRY PROCESS — The entry fee for each hunter division is \$400. An open check payable to the Legacy Cup must accompany each entry.

REFUNDS — Scratches made later than one hour before the start of each section will not receive an entry refund.

STABLING INFORMATION—See page 3 of Kentucky Spring Prize List or call 859-233-0492. Feed & Bedding orders may be placed with Dever Show Services at 859-233-9702.

STABLING & USEF FEES—Each Legacy Cup exhibitor must also fill out and sign a Kentucky Spring Horse Shows Entry Form. All Fees other than those itemized on the Legacy Cup Entry Form must be paid to the Kentucky Spring Horse Shows. All horses entered in the Legacy Cup must comply with US Equestrian Drugs & Medications rules and are subject to random drug testing.

COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATES—Proof of negative Coggins Test within one year is required of every horse entering the Kentucky Horse Park. Out of state horses must be accompanied by a current health certificate (within 30 days). This paperwork must accompany the horse on arrival. Do **NOT** send with entries. *Please see enclosed insert for more details.*

POLING—There will be no manual poling or offsets allowed on the show grounds at any time.

HARD HATS must be worn by exhibitors at all times while mounted. Riders are required to wear ASTM and SEI approved helmets at all times while mounted.

JUMP ORDERS will be posted each morning for that day's activity. Late entries not on the class sheet will be put at the top of the order. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders or trainers who have conflicts should inform the manager prior to the conflict so that necessary adjustment can be made to the order of go.

THE LEGACY CUP COMMITTEE AND MANAGER reserve the right to reschedule, combine, close, add or delete classes or change the officials as may be necessary in the best interests of the show.

QUESTIONS AND DISPUTES will be brought in writing to the Legacy Cup Appeals Committee for resolution. The decision of the Legacy Cup Appeals Committee will be final and the entrant will accept such decision as final and hold the Legacy Cup Appeals Committee harmless for any action taken.

COURSES will consist of hunter type jumps; go-rounds will have approximately 8 jumps; finals will have 10-12 jumps.

ALL LEGACY CUP HUNTER DIVISIONS will be judged on performance and soundness. All rounds will be judged numerically by multiple teams of two judges. The scores will be added for a composite score. All finals will be run using a clean slate format. A tie breaking team of judges will be designated before each round. In the case of a tie, the score of the tie breaking team of judges will determine the winner. Ties in the go-round qualifying classes will be broken only for the distribution of money, however all placing in the top 25 will qualify for the finals round.

NO RIDER CHANGES will be allowed. The same horse and rider combination must compete in both the go round and finals round within a Legacy Cup division.

RING SPECIFICATIONS—The Indoor Arena footing and Indoor schooling area consists of a mixture of sand and loam. The outside schooling area consists of a limestone base and mortar sand cushion. **INDOOR ARENA:** 145' X 285', **INDOOR SCHOOLING** 60' X 110', **OUTDOOR SCHOOLING,** 150' X 250'

Horses eligible for the Pre green incentive must declare on entry blank. No additional entry fee. A Pre-green horse is defined as one in its first or second year of showing and has not shown at 3'6" at any horse show. Ribbons awarded to the top eight Pre-green horses. The results of the Pre Green Incentive will be based on the top eight composite scores after the completion of the Pro 3' Final's Round.

RESTRICTED PROFESSIONAL HUNTER DIVISION*No Additional Entry Fee*

Riders must declare themselves as a Restricted Pro Rider. The status will be subject to the approval of the Legacy Cup Committee. A Restricted Pro Rider is a new professional or one who has not consistently won at upper levels of show hunter riding. Additionally, the status will be based on Legacy Cup money earnings. Rider's who have won more than \$5,000 at Legacy Cup competition or who have placed first or second in Legacy Cup Pro 3', 3'6" Finals are ineligible to declare themselves as a Restricted Pro Rider. Once a rider declares himself a pro rider or has moved up by money won, he is no longer eligible for Restricted Pro competition.

Restricted Pro classes run concurrently with the Open Professional classes. The top 10 Restricted Pro riders will advance to a Restricted Pro Finals run concurrently with the Open Pro Finals.
